Offering 400 square metres of living space on three decks with three guest cabins, *Geisha* is ideal for a private holiday for up to six guests. The master cabin with an en-suite bathroom and walk-in closet is located on the top deck with stunning 180 degrees views through floor-to-ceiling windows.
