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A REWARDING STAY FOR BARCELONA MARATHON 2016 RUNNERS

Hong Kong, 19 January 2016 – <u>Mandarin Oriental, Barcelona</u> is offering Barcelona Marathon 2016 runners an opportunity to relax and revive themselves at the hotel after the event. Leading up to the marathon, runners can prepare for the event by taking advantage of the *Get Ready for the Marathon Programme*, a special, personalized training plan designed by <u>The</u> <u>Spa at the Mandarin Oriental, Barcelona</u> in collaboration with prestigious Ergodinámica Clínica. Athletes will receive a comprehensive, computerized body–condition analysis prior

- 1 hour personalized stretching session
- 1 hour personalized strength session

The programme is for one person, is subject to availability and needs to be booked at least one week in advance. Accommodation is not included.
