A selection of hand-crafted Champagne cocktails will also be available and will include: The Monsieur *vanilla simple syrup, kirsch brandy and Luxardo cherry;* The Madame *honey, pear, ginger and fresh sage;* and The Mademoiselle *Mandarin juice with rosemary syrup.*
