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MANDARIN ORIENTAL, GENEVA – THE CITY’S MOST LUXURIOUS GUESTROOMS AND SUITES

Mandarin Oriental, Geneva’s 189 spacious guestrooms, including 27 suites, completed full renovation in early 2013. The rooms and suites, many which feature stunning views of Rhône River and Geneva’s Old Town, have been considerably extended and now resemble luxurious and desirable apartments with a residential feel.

A unique convenience in all rooms is a sliding cabinet which cleverly incorporates the mini-bar and laundry compartment, accessible by housekeeping from the outside, allowing for seamless delivery of dry-cleaning, polished shoes and restocking of drinks with no disturbance to guests.

SPACIOUS GUESTROOMS

The interiors of the guestrooms were designed by renowned French artist, Sybille de Margerie, and combine intelligent symmetry with clean curves, embellished with new elegant furnishings. Modern Art's bold flourishes are softened by the sun-filled palette of soothing earth tones; greens, browns and creams.

Luxury materials have been used throughout: parquet, Greek marble and soft wool carpets are the principal materials for the flooring; the remainders of the fittings are in leather, silk, mohair and wood veneer. Every item of furniture is Swiss-made.

Every room features a desk, two telephone lines; four telephone handsets, including one in the bathroom; a LCD flat-screen television, a laser printer and an electronic safe.

Each of the spacious bathrooms is decorated in fine Greek St. Helena marble and features separate baths and rain-showers, bidets and towel heaters.

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The Mandarin Rooms

Located on the hotel's sixth floor, these spacious rooms blend contemporary Sybille de Margerie design with effortless elegance and offer magnificent views over the river Rhone, city and mountains. Available with a choice of king or twin beds, the Mandarin Rooms offer a choice of two sophisticated palettes; fuchsia and silver or delicate tones of gold. Furnished with plush carpets, a comfortable sofa, working desk and luxurious touches such as silk cushions and adjustable lighting, the rooms offer a welcoming ambience. The room boasts two Italian marble bathrooms, one with a walk-in shower and the other a stand-alone bath, and both with elegant vanity area and relaxing, spa-like feel.

STUNNING SUITES

Junior Terrace Suites & The Oriental Suite

These suites have been designed by Buz Design of Hong Kong who has created a contemporary urban retreat concept. All of the suites have private terraces which allow guests to enjoy panoramic views of the Rhône River, Geneva's historic Old Town and the surrounding snow-capped mountains. Perfect for families, most are inter-connecting and can be converted into one oversized luxury apartment. Each suite features Mandarin Oriental's sophisticated guest technology which includes wireless broadband and B&O televisions with a highly sophisticated entertainment system.

The Junior Terrace Suites offer beautifully spacious rooms with high ceilings and are decorated in warm earth-coloured tones creating a calming effect. The furnishings are contemporary with a touch of modern art which links back to the original design of the hotel. All suites have luxurious, spacious bathrooms and a glass wall that allows natural light from the living room to filter in.

The Oriental Suite is ultra-luxurious; it covers 150 sqm and has a large living room, dining room with a butler's pantry, bedroom with walk-in closet, spacious bathroom and its own spa facilities, including a hamman. It also has a 62 sqm terrace with panoramic vistas over the

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river and the Salève mountain. The design complements the new Junior Suites with stylish furniture and modern art design elements.

The Presidential Suite

One of the hotel's premier suites is the Presidential Suite, located on the very top floor with a 360 degree view and its own elevator. The Presidential Suite combines Art Deco elegance and comfort; direct elevator access means that discretion and tranquillity is guaranteed. There is also a private staircase that links to the Royale Mandarin Suite below. The Presidential's terrace looks out over the city, the lake, harbour, the Salève mountain and ultimately - weather permitting - the famous Mont-Blanc peak.

The Royal Mandarin Suite

Offering a spectacular level of luxury, this magnificent suite takes pride of place on the sixth floor of the hotel. Seamlessly blending contemporary design with effortless elegance, the exquisite accommodation includes a large bedroom beautifully furnished with king bed, a private dressing room and stunning white marble master bathroom. Decorated in sophisticated tones of gold and burgundy, the suite is accessed via a private elevator from reception, allowing guests a sense of privacy and exclusivity. Flooded with natural light and boasting views over the river, city and mountains, the suite is ideal for entertaining with a dining room that can seat up to eight guests, a large living area furnished with a selection of sumptuous soft furnishings and a fully-equipped kitchen. In addition, there are three further bathrooms and the option of connecting to an adjoining suite and room.

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
