MANDARIN ORIENTAL, HONG KONG – LEGENDARY DINING

Mandarin Oriental, Hong Kong is home to ten highly individual bars and restaurants, including much-loved greats and three Michelin-star venues, offering guests a series of legendary dining experiences.

Pierre is the stunning two Michelin-starred restaurant, situated on the 25th floor that offers floor-to-ceiling windows framing Victoria Harbour and is Pierre Gagnaire’s pied-à-terre in Hong Kong. Gagnaire is the wizard of innovative French gastronomy, and one of the most original and artistic chefs in the world today. His astonishingly intricate and elaborate dishes are often described as “modern French”, although his style remains firmly rooted in the French cooking tradition, resulting in dishes that are exquisitely presented and utterly original. Under the watchful eye of Jacky Tauvry, Chef de Cuisine at Pierre, the menu changes seasonally, with express lunch and *dégustation* dinner menus served alongside the à-la-carte choices.
