### **RECEPTION/**

**MEETING ROOMS:** The hotel features a 6,000 square-foot pillar-less ballroom with three walls of windows providing stunning views overlooking Central Park, along with three additional meeting rooms for smaller executive meetings. Exceptional banqueting and conference services are provided.

**SPA/FITNESS CENTER:** Located on floors 35 and 36, the Five-Star Spa at Mandarin Oriental, New York spans 14,500 square feet. The award-winning Spa is distinguished by its exclusive treatments including:

The Spa features separate men's and women's Heat Experience rooms with oxygen-intensified vitality pools, steam rooms and experience showers, an Oriental Tea Lounge as well as men's and women's Relaxation Lounges.



For more active pursuits, The Spa features state-of-the-art workout facilities on the 36<sup>th</sup> Floor. TechnoGym Cardio equipment and Kinesis Personal Heritage system are found at the spacious fitness center, and an indoor 75-foot lap pool with scenic Hudson River views rounds out offerings. Owners have full access to Mandarin Oriental, New York’s amenities – including Housekeeping, In-Room Dining, Concierge, Pool & Fitness Center and other personalized services to complement their lifestyles.

**SHOPPING:**
