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MANDARIN ORIENTAL, PRAGUE – ROOMS AND SUITES

Mandarin Oriental, Prague is undoubtedly one of the most luxurious and exclusive places to stay in Prague. Housed in a former monastery whose origins date back to the 14th Century, the hotel is filled with carefully preserved artefacts and original architectural details. At every opportunity, the splendour of the city has been framed through arched windows along the wide corridors, through picture windows and from the large private terrace.

Each of the 99 rooms and suites has been individually furnished and decorated to embrace the best of the destination whilst adding a touch of Oriental flair. All guestrooms are extremely spacious and exquisitely furnished, with high ceilings, often either vaulted or arched. Natural woven rugs, polished stones and original parquet floors highlight the history of the premises. The oversized bathrooms, conceived as private spas, are clad in polished limestone and feature heated floors and luxury bath products by Diptyque. Contemporary Asian touches complete the experience, whilst the sensuous, tactile surfaces of drapes, throw pillows and even upholstery produce a feeling of understated opulence.

In each room, the latest technology is discreetly concealed behind the exquisite, handcrafted finishes, allowing guests to work in comfort or to make the most of in-room entertainment. Each guest room has two telephone lines with voicemail, high-speed Internet access (both wired and wireless), in-room safe, a personal bar and refrigerator, as well as two high-definition LCD televisions, one in the bathroom and another in the bedroom (suites feature a third set in their living rooms).

Thirteen Deluxe Terrace Rooms introduced in the summer of 2012 offer the ultimate luxury in an urban setting – a private patio overlooking the hotel's own beautiful flower garden, accessible directly from the room via French doors. Ideal for a sunlit, leisurely al fresco breakfast or a romantic dinner under the stars, the Deluxe Terrace Rooms are a unique offering unparalleled elsewhere in central Prague.

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The hotel prides itself on five unique signature suites: Moser Crystal Suite – is located in the Baroque wing of the hotel and is distinctive not just for its generous size and original architectural features (including vaulted ceilings, tall windows and original parquet floors) but also for their sumptuous ambience. The room feature exquisite crystal accessories and stunning decorations by Moser, the Czech Republic's premier crystal manufacturer. The overall feel is one of absolute luxury.

The Oriental Suite, at 74 square metres, is located at the top of the former Renaissance chapel that houses the Spa. Its distinct character, curved walls meeting in a pointed arch and slightly mysterious yet warm atmosphere, make it perfect for romantic escapes.

The elegant, extensive Lazar Suite in the historical Baroque building is a fit for rock stars or royalty. In 2012, the suite was perfected for families who prefer comfort and privacy. The suite offers 150 square metres of luxurious space and combines two luxury suites connected with an intimate foyer and offers two or three bedrooms with vaulted ceilings in the exquisite Baroque area of Mandarin Oriental, Prague.

The luxurious Lobkowicz Suite exudes Czech history and tradition, featuring an exclusive selection of lithographs' facsimiles from The Lobkowicz collections. Located in the Baroque wing of the hotel, the suite offers a sumptuous atmosphere as well as original architectural features like vaulted ceiling, tall windows, and original parquet floors. Exhibited artworks feature period views of Prague, mainly of the picturesque Lesser Town and Prague Castle, and were carefully selected and framed by The Lobkowicz Collections' curators. A 5% proceed from the Lobkowicz Suite bookings goes to Lobkowicz Foundation for the conservation and restoration of the largest private collection in the Czech Republic.

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Meanwhile, the 150 square-metre Presidential Penthouse Suite is located on the fifth-floor penthouse and enjoys commanding views of the entire city. The most prestigious suite in the hotel, it features a large private roof terrace – an impressive vantage point from which to admire stunning views of Prague Castle or entertain a small al fresco party.

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
