



Cultural Tour

The city of Hong Kong is exciting and vibrant, with tradition and culture all around. Take a guided tour and enjoy the diversity and excitement that Hong Kong has to offer.

This guided walk introduces you to the living culture of Yau Ma Tei and Mong Kong districts, and Kowloon area, where life for many is lived at street level. The journey begins from Yuen Po Street Bird Garden - an attractive Chinese courtyard garden that houses bird sellers and their song birds and then continues to the Flower Market - the centre of Hong Kong's wholesale and retail flower business. From the Flower Market, the tour will take you past the Goldfish Market which is very popular due to the belief that goldfish stabilises feng shui, before visiting Shanghai Street, one of the city's oldest streets where you'll find shops selling traditional Chinese utensils, ceremonial items and traditional Chinese wedding gowns.

Time: up to four hours for up to four guests

Proposed Itinerary:

9:00 a.m.	Depart from hotel and take MTR to Prince Edward Station
9:30 a.m.	Arrive at Prince Edward Station and walk to the Bird Garden
9:45 a.m.	Arrive at the Bird Garden
10:15 a.m.	Depart from the Bird Garden and walk to Flower Market
10:45 a.m.	Walk from Flower Market to Shanghai Street via Garden Street.
	Guest will visit Gold Fish Street, Garden Street Market etc along the way.
11:30 a.m.	Arrive Shanghai Street, walk to Jordan Road along Shanghai Street
12:30 p.m.	Arrive Jordan Road, take MTR from Jordan Station to Central
1:00 p.m.	Arrive back at the hotel.





Art Tour

China is fast becoming the largest art market in the world and Hong Kong remains at the heart of this. ART HK 12 endorsed this with over 67,000 buyers and collectors visiting this exciting and vibrant fair over three days.

Immerse yourself in this exciting art scene with this guided tour. Your first stop will be a visit to the Pedder Building, now home to galleries such as Gagosian, Ben Brown, HanArt and Pearl Lam. You will then take the world's longest outdoor escalator up to the Hollywood Road where galleries sit alongside elegant antique shops that are home to valuable pieces from the Ming and Qing Dynasties. Your tour will briefly stop at Man Mo temple, before descending to Upper Lascar Row that will allow you to search for your own treasure from the array of delicate handicrafts, ancient pieces of jade and classic Chinese furniture.

Time: up to four hours for up to four guests

Proposed Itinerary:

2:00 p.m. Depart hotel and walk to the Pedder Building

3:30 p.m. Walk and take the escalator up to the Hollywood Road

6:00 p.m. Tram back to the hotel.

Food Tour

Renowned as the culinary capital of Asia, Hong Kong boasts more than 11,000 restaurants, many of which are clustered in defined food districts. Dim Sum means literally to "touch the heart" and Hong Kong's dining scene is at the heart of everything.

The sights, sounds, smells and colours of a trip to a local food market will stay with you forever. Mix with the local residents as they set about buying their fresh daily produce as the guide points out many of the local ingredients. Sheung Wan is famed for its dried fish market, along with selling exotic resources that are believed to aid health and beauty. Walk through this area with the guide and learn more about these beliefs.


9.00 a.m. Depart hotel and go to Wan Chai Food Market

11:00 a.m. Tram back to Sheung Wan to explore dried fish markets

1.00 a.m. Back to hotel by tram.





Shopping Tour

People in Hong Kong love fashion and shopping, and this buzzing metropolis offers something for everyone. Luxury designer stores surround the hotel showcasing the latest collections in flagship stores, while unique boutiques and vibrant markets such as the Ladies Market and the Jade Market are a short MTR ride away.

Hong Kong's street markets each have their own character and a trip to one of these will allow guests to hone their bargaining skills and return with a local treat for all their loved ones. Jade is associated with good health and long life and the Jade Market offers 400 stalls selling everything from expensive carved pieces to cheap trinkets. The Ladies Market is the place to visit for inexpensive clothing, toys, bags and accessories and the nearby streets offer the latest electronics and even trainers on a street known as 'Sneaker Street'.

Proposed Itinerary:

2:00 p.m. Depart hotel and commence shopping (maximum one or two districts)

6:00 p.m. Arrive back at the hotel.



Terms and Conditions:

- The guide service is for one to four guests maximum and a maximum of four hours
- The above guided tours can be arranged in English, Mandarin, German, French, Spanish and Italian, subject to availability at time of booking.
- All transport arranged will be by public transport (i.e. MTR or Tram). Taxis or chauffeur driven cars can be arranged at an additional cost to the guest.
- Tea, coffee and any food breaks will be at the guests own expense.
- Tours can be tailored for guests in advance.
- Extension to tour times or merging of two tours can be arranged at additional charge to guests.
- Reservations are required to be made one week in advance.
- The tour date and pick-up time can be adjusted up to 48 hours prior to tour.
- Any cancellation, or change of date and time, within 48 hours prior to the date of tour, will incur a 50% charge.
- Any cancellation within 24 hours or 'no show' will incur a 100% charge.
- Service gratuity is at the guest's discretion.
