



THAILAND PASS TRAVELLER JOURNEY

The Kingdom of Thailand is delighted to **welcome all travellers.**

Thailand defines fully vaccinated travellers as those having completed the vaccination process at least two weeks prior to arrival with any of the following vaccines. Two doses of all vaccines are needed except for Johnson and Johnson that requires one shot only.

1. CoronaVac (Sinovac)
2. AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria, Covishield)
3. Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty, Tozinameran (INN))
4. Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)
5. Moderna (Spikevax)
6. COVILLO (Sinopharm)
7. Sputnik V
8. Covaxin
9. Novavax (Nuvaxovid) / Covovax
10. Medigen

*Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated travellers can arrive using a negative RT-PCR test taken less than 72 hours prior to departure.



Entry into Thailand requires pre-approval via an **online application for a Thailand Pass.**

Prepare the following required documents as soft copy files. Please note PDF files are not accepted on this website.

- Passport.
- COVID-19 vaccination certificate.
- Insurance with minimum coverage of USD 10,000.
- Obtain your Thailand Pass by registering on **tp.consular.go.th**. Thailand Pass approval will be instantaneous.
- Fill in your details and upload the required documents (as described above).
- You may add dependent children under 18 years of age to your application.
- Obtain your Thailand Pass QR Code.

Please note that we strongly recommend you bring a printed copy of all documentation related to your travel and vaccination status.
