MANDARIN ORIENTAL, BANGKOK - ROOMS AND SUITES

For more than 145 years, travellers have followed the Chao Phraya River to stay at the legendary [Mandarin Oriental, Bangkok](#). In keeping with the 2016 successful restoration of the Authors' and Garden Wings, 2019 saw a celebrated revival of this Grand Dame as they completed a USD 90-million loving renovation to the entire River Wing.

Inspired by the hotel's Chao Phraya River location and reflecting the spirit of Bangkok and the hotel's iconic history, internationally renowned designer Jeffrey Wilkes oversaw the redesign of all the River Wing [rooms and suites](#). Light and fresh details, from Royal Barge sculptures in hammered brass to the river's reflection in the rugs and teak floors, lend tropical notes and are complemented by whitewashed wooden panelling, textured linen drapes and rich fabrics from Jim Thompson, in addition to the technology and convenience of the 21st century in the design. Balconies and floor-to-ceiling windows serve to bring the River of Kings into rooms and suites. The newly redesigned guestrooms, ranging in size from 38 to 63 sqm, are all elegantly inspired by the essence of the hotel's historic riverside location, and feature teakwood floors, carefully crafted furniture and beautiful Thai silks, enhancing the resort-style ambience.

The hotel's 60 suites range in size from the 83sqm Chao Phraya Suite, located in the Garden Wing facing the majestic Chao Phraya River, to the 376sqm new Oriental Suite, comprising two bedrooms with a wrap-around 58sqm terrace, large sitting room, dining room for 12 and its own entertainment room, all offering guests sweeping views of the River of Kings.

Deluxe Rooms - These elegant 38sqm rooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows, wooden floors and river-inspired rugs and furnishings. Soft natural tones and Thai décor add to the overall resort-style ambience, while guests can also relax on a private balcony and enjoy views of bustling life in the Thai capital.

Deluxe Premier Rooms - These 42sqm rooms are located in the River Wing and each boasts a large sofa to relax and enjoy river and city views. Décor is inspired by life on the Chao Phraya river, with wooden floors and Thai touches such as teak furniture and beautiful Thai silk fabrics, while a selection of prints from the hotel's rich collection of artworks adorn the walls. Both king and twin beds are available.

Deluxe Balcony Rooms - Each of these rooms boasts a private 6sqm balcony on which to relax and enjoy views of the bustling river life and the pool. With floor-to-ceiling windows, wooden floors, rugs and furnishings inspired by nature, soft natural tones and Thai décor, these 38sqm rooms add to the overall resort-style ambience.

Mandarin Rooms - The ideal choice for guests looking for more space, these large 63sqm rooms incorporate a spacious seating area with a sofa and dining area overlooking both the city and river through floor-to-ceiling windows. The décor is light and cheerful with soothing aqua and gold tones balanced with a selection of furnishings upholstered in the finest Thai silks, along with a king-size bed swathed in luxurious linen. The room also features a spacious vanity area and walk-in closet.

State Rooms - Entered via a teak-panelled hallway, these rooms are richly decorated in traditional Thai style with dark wooden furnishings and brightly coloured Jim Thompson silks. In the bedroom of these 61sqm rooms there is a seating area furnished with a comfortable sofa and dining table. Large floor-to-ceiling windows open to a spacious balcony from where guests can enjoy wonderful panoramic river views.

Deluxe Suites - These 83sqm suites feature a spacious living area with a large sofa and beautiful wooden floors. Decorated in Thai silks in warm tones, the separate living and dining area offers a peaceful setting for relaxing while also allowing privacy. The bedroom features a dressing and sitting area with a large walk-in closet while the bathroom features Italian marble with double vanities and a separate shower and bath.

Deluxe Two Bedroom Suites - These 125sqm two-bedroom Deluxe Suites are ideal for families and overlook the pool and river. Guests can relax and unwind on their private balcony with a seating area, or in the living area that offers separate sitting and dining sections for family and friends to enjoy. The master bedroom has a dressing and sitting area with a large walk-in closet, while the bathroom features Italian marble and a separate shower and bath.

Junior Terrace Suites - Ideal for long-staying guests, these large 97sqm junior suites feature a stunning 17sqm terrace that overlooks the river and city. The suites combine a spacious open-plan living area with a large sofa and armchairs, a writing desk and a dining table seating up to five. It is decorated with wooden floors throughout and accented with rugs and prints from the hotel's art collection inspired by the Chao Phraya River.

Authors Suites - Individually designed, each 101sqm suite pays tribute in name and ambience, from colour scheme and antique decorations, to one of the celebrated authors who have stayed with us. Located in the River Wing, all feature floor-to-ceiling windows and a balcony that directly overlooks the river - perfect for relaxing and watching river life. Each suite has a spacious sitting room, a bedroom that features a dressing and seating area and a large Italian marble bathroom and walk-in closet.

Deluxe Theme Suites - Inspired by historic ships of the 1800s that sailed and traded in Bangkok, these 83sqm suites are located on the 16th floor and offer river views and a private 6sqm balcony with seating. Each suite features a spacious living area with a large sofa, wooden floors and a dining table. The large bedroom has a dressing area with a walk-in closet. The bathroom features Italian marble with a walk-in shower and separate bathtub.

Deluxe Two-Bedroom Theme Suites - These two-bedroom suites on the hotel's top floor feature a 6sqm balcony offering views of the river. Inspired by historic ships of the 1800s that sailed and traded in Bangkok, these 125sqm suites are ideal for watching the boats of today passing by. Home to a large sitting area, a dining table and an additional powder room, these suites are ideal for friends or families travelling together. The bedrooms are comfortable and spacious with a dressing area and walk-in closet.

Premier Suites - These spacious 108sqm suites overlook the French Ambassador's residence, with breath-taking views of the Chao Phraya River, a private balcony and sitting area. Elegantly decorated, the Premier Suites have wooden floors in the living and dining areas, complemented

perfectly by rugs and prints from the hotel's art collection that are inspired by the 'River of Kings'. The bedroom features a subtle orchid theme, a dressing and sitting area and a walk-in closet.

Premier Two-Bedroom Suites - These large 150sqm suites offer breath-taking river views and are ideal for families who desire additional space and luxury. The separate living area offers both privacy and comfort with a large sofa and a dining area for five guests. The elegant suite features wooden floors in both the living and dining areas, with river-inspired rugs and artefacts, as well as prints from the hotel's art collection. It also has a private balcony with sitting area.

Siam Suite - Furnished with Thai antiques from Chiang Mai, magnificent Persian carpets and a varied art collection, this Thai-styled suite is beautifully appointed and eminently comfortable. Large floor-to-ceiling windows open out over the river, flooding the rooms with light, while a carved lotus cornice is one of many authentic local touches. The 107sqm suite features a separate living area, as well as a dining area for five guests. It also has a private balcony with a seating area overlooking the river.

Selandia Suite - This two-bedroom suite is named after the famed ship (The Selandia) that in 1912 was the world's first diesel-powered ocean-going ship and completed its maiden voyage from Copenhagen to Bangkok. The 169sqm suite is beautifully decorated in hues of pale ivory against a background of hazy blues and rich scarlets. Furnished with silk throughout, every detail from brass-cornered tables to plush seating exudes luxurious elegance. It features a large living and dining area and two balconies.

Oriental Suite - This stunning two-bedroom penthouse has played host to royalty and heads of state and offers amazing full river views with a wrap-around 57.6sqm terrace. Decorated with Thai silks, it also features teak floors and Persian carpets. The spacious living room has multiple sitting areas and a private dining room for 12 guests, in addition to a full kitchen that is ideal for entertaining. The master bedroom is spacious and stylish, furnished with antiques and a unique pineapple canopy bed. This 376sqm suite even comes complete with its own entertainment room.

GARDEN WING

Chao Phraya Rooms - Located in the Garden Wing, these rooms, with either a flat or split-level layout, offer a residential ambience. The rooms are the epitome of classic elegance with a colonial-inspired contemporary interior design that reflects the hotel's unique heritage and Thai culture. The 35sqm rooms also enjoy floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the river and garden.

Chao Phraya Suites - These spacious 83sqm suites, located in the Garden Wing, have either a flat or split-level layout, as well as floor-to-ceiling windows and a balcony overlooking the Chao Phraya river and gardens. The suites feature a colonial-inspired contemporary interior design to reflect the hotel's unique heritage and Thai culture. A separate lounge with dining area is offered alongside a luxurious bedroom and large marble bathroom with separate bathtub, walk-in shower and walk-in closet.

Ambassador Suite - Located in the original Oriental Hotel, this unique 173sqm suite exudes luxurious sophistication with beautiful views from a private Victorian-inspired glass

conservatory. Lavishly decorated in shades of green and white to exude state grandeur, this expansive suite has two living rooms for ultimate relaxation. The master bedroom connects to a second guest bedroom making it ideal for families while the bathroom comes complete with rain shower and walk-in closet.

Royal Suite - Our jewel in the historic crown is the 306sqm Royal Suite designed to suit official and security needs of discerning guests. It offers private access, meeting, fitness and spa facilities, as well as additional bedrooms to accommodate family and entourage. It is decorated in sumptuous royal colours of purples and yellows that juxtapose with white marble and crystal chandeliers for an ambience of classical but understated elegance.
