## Kinu by Takagi - Refined Kaiseki dining in an intimate setting

Kinu by Takagi is the latest addition to Mandarin Oriental, Bangkok's award-winning portfolio of restaurants. Chef Takagi Kazuo owns the two-Michelin-starred Kyoto Cuisine Takagi, and is bringing his refined Kyoto-style cuisine, known as 'Kyo-ryori', to the Thai capital for the first time. His composed, delicate and expressive dishes reflect the seasons and cultures of both Japan and Thailand by integrating a number of local Thai ingredients alongside the finest Japanese produce. The 10-seat restaurant will offer Kaiseki dining, the refined and elegant iteration of Japanese cuisine that is a true expression of culinary skill and experience. As with Omakase dining, guests leave themselves in the hands of the chef as he creates a 12-course seasonal menu that is an elegant celebration of Japanese-styled Minka area, before diners are led to the counter where the real theatre begins as they witness the chef, a true master, at work. The experience is completed with a tea ceremony, while guests may also choose to enjoy one of Bangkok's finest sake collections.
