With its relaxing yet elegant atmosphere, the river-fronted Café Calla will feature 120 seats, including a 10-seat Chef's Table and a 34-seat outdoor Parisian terrace, complemented by a walk-in 1'500-bottle wine cellar. A cheese glass dome will be available for dinner only and guests will enjoy live cooking stands and a seasonal buffet during the restaurant's Sunday Brunch.
