The four-course lunch menu and six-course dinner menu by Pierre Gagnaire are priced CHF 125 and CHF 225 respectively. Café Calla's tables seat up to eight people each. Total restaurant seating is limited to 80 people for both lunch and dinner. Lunch will be served from noon to 1.30pm, and dinner from 7pm to 9.30pm.
