The Loft, an upscale whisky and wine bar, is ideal for intimate drinks, while The Taikoo Lounge serves elegant afternoon teas and ideal venue for a casual tête-à-tête.

The Spa at Mandarin Oriental, Guangzhou offers city dwellers and visitors a rare opportunity for peace and tranquillity, it's also the only Forbes Five Star Spa in the city. The Group's signature holistic treatments are designed to relax and rejuvenate, and are complemented by an extensive menu of wellness, massage and beauty options. The Spa features nine private treatment rooms, including two couple's suites and a VIP spa suite, as well as extensive heat and water facilities.
