Further enticing dining options include: <u>CO.MO Bar & Bistrot</u>, with its Italian contemporary menu, handmade pizzas and signature pre and after-dinner drinks; and <u>L^ARIA</u>, serving refined Italian cuisine with Japanese influences, paired with stunning lakeside views.
