- In September 2016, Mandarin Oriental Hyde Park, London embarked on an exciting two-year phased restoration designed to significantly enhance the facilities of the hotel and position it as one of the best in the world.
- Mandarin Oriental Hyde Park, London completed its most extensive restoration in its 117- year history, on Monday 15 April 2019.

Location and Transport:

- Situated in the heart of Knightsbridge, London's most fashionable shopping district.
- The north side of the hotel faces Hyde Park, offering panoramic views over Royal Parkland.
- A short walk from the city's finest shopping, cultural and entertainment areas.
- Knightsbridge underground station is situated beside the hotel.
- Gatwick Express to Gatwick Airport (from Victoria Station) and Heathrow Express to Heathrow Airport (from Paddington Station) both a short taxi ride away.
- Valet Parking and Chauffeured Limousine Service available.

Guestrooms and Suites:

- Internationally renowned designer, Joyce Wang has overseen the design of the 141 spacious guestrooms and 40 luxurious suites. Each one encompasses details inspired by the building's Edwardian heritage and the natural beauty of Hyde Park, as well as the glamour of the early 20th century Golden Age of Travel.
- All rooms offer views either over tranquil Hyde Park, a quiet courtyard or fashionable Knightsbridge.
- All accommodation comes equipped with GHD hair straighteners, Nespresso coffee makers, Diptyque bathroom amenities and hair products.
- Many of the hotel's suites feature private terraces and balconies.
- Every suite has curated libraries by Heywood Hill, record players with vintage vinyl collections and yoga mats for private practice.
- The ninth floor offers two penthouse suites -Mandarin and Oriental- which can be interconnected to create one of London's largest suites with three bedrooms, the Mandarin Oriental Penthouse, offering unparalleled views of Hyde Park and the city's skyline.
- Personalised butler service available.

- The Rosebery - serving famed Afternoon Tea and offers all day dining and cocktails.

- Heat and Water Oasis includes a Sauna, Amethyst Crystal Steam Room, Vitality Pool and Zen Colour Therapy Relaxation Area.
- Wellbeing and Fitness centre with 24-hour state-of-the-art fitness technology by Technogym®, including Treadmills, Cross Trainers, Bikes and a Rowing Machine.
- Indoor 17-metre twin lane, stainless-steel heated swimming pool with lap timer.
- Post-work out Four Senses Loungers designed to entice the four senses resulting in the ultimate relaxation.

Meeting and Event Rooms:

- All meeting rooms have been redesigned by interior designer Joyce Wang.
- Five versatile meeting and event rooms, all boasting natural daylight for up to 650 guests.
