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MANDARIN ORIENTAL RITZ, MADRID – ROOMS & SUITES

Encompassing the hotel's top six floors, Mandarin Oriental Ritz, Madrid's 100 rooms and 53 suites are among the finest in Spain. Following an extensive renovation by design duo Gilles & Boissier, the décor has a classic, contemporary feel with a soothing colour palette, luxurious fabrics and designer furnishings. As part of the refurbishment, all rooms have been enlarged and new suites created to offer guests the ultimate in luxurious city accommodation.

Rooms

Each of the 100 rooms offer city views and a sophisticated ambience and the average size of all rooms and suites was increased during the hotel's recent renovation. Ranging in size from 29-49sqm, the Superior, Deluxe and Mandarin rooms offer an abundance of space.

Rooms have been designed to be modern yet functional, with elegant furnishings such as four-poster canopy beds and leather chairs, coffee-coloured wood floors and white moulding on the floors and ceilings. Each room offers a state-of-the-art in-room entertainment system and high speed WiFi connectivity.

The bathrooms are equally as luxurious, with Dolomite style panelling, fine mouldings and a marble Emperor's floor. Divided into zoned areas, the bathrooms feature large bathtubs, a rain shower and twin washbasins. Accessible rooms, twin rooms and connecting bedrooms are all available.

Suites

With 53 suites in total, Mandarin Oriental Ritz, Madrid offers a large range of accommodation options for guests. There are five suite categories, ranging in size from the 49sqm Junior Suite up to the 188sqm Royal Suite, all with fabulous views and excellent facilities.

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Junior Suite

Creatively designed with an inviting, relaxing feel, these elegant suites feature a private bedroom and a large living area with a choice of seating. Enjoying a classic-contemporary décor by Paris-based design house Gilles & Boissier, the suite's two windows overlook the hotel's peaceful inner, sun-drenched courtyard. Bathrooms with Dolomite stone panelling, fine mouldings and a marble Emperor's floor are divided into zoned areas and feature a freestanding bathtub and twin washbasins.

Premier Junior Suite

Overlooking the Lealtad Square of Prado Museum, the décor of these suites has been inspired by the stunning city views. Living rooms feature elegant furnishings and fine white mouldings with gold detailing, with large windows opening up to the Madrid skyline. Bathrooms are fashioned from white Dolomite stone panelling with Emperor marble floors divided into zone areas with a freestanding bath and twin vanity unit.

Palm Court Suite

Enjoying the benefit of a separate living room, these suites are overlooking the hotel's peaceful courtyard. Designed so as to maximise space, Palm Court Suites feature a classic-contemporary décor by Gilles & Boissier. All suites have private bedrooms and marble ensuite bathrooms, whilst some have guest powder rooms.

Park Suite

Park Suites offer views of Madrid's most secret garden in Lealtad Square and benefit from generously sized living and sleeping areas. A floor-to-ceiling glass wall separates the bedroom from the Dolomite stone panelled bathroom, which features fine mouldings and Emperador marble floors. Divided into zoned areas, the bathroom has a large freestanding bath and twin washbasins. Most suites also enjoy the benefit of a guest powder room.

Prado Suite

Named after the world-famous art gallery it overlooks, these unique suites have generously sized bedrooms separated by floor-to-ceiling glass from a large living room. Features of note include fine mouldings with gold finishes, exquisite soft furnishings and elegant oak floors. Bathrooms are equally as impressive with Dolomite stone panelling, fine mouldings, Emperador marble floors, a freestanding bath and twin washbasins. Most of the suites enjoy the benefit of a guest powder room.

Turret Suite

Our spacious Turret Suites are composed of three different areas, a spacious master bedroom, an in-suite bathroom and a living room. Designed as a serene escape from the city, the bedroom features a light wooden floor and delicate design details on the walls and ceiling. The large bed is backed by a Spanish leather headboard with two balloon lamps either side. An ottoman armchair is located next to the window, providing an additional comfort area for reading, relaxing or simply enjoying a glass of wine.

With dolomite stone panelling and refined mouldings, the bathrooms are zoned into areas with a comfortable bathtub, rain shower and twin washbasins.

The spacious living room is the perfect area for guests to organise private meetings or relax. With a round natural mica ceiling, white lacquered wooden panels and light wooden floors furnishings include an integrated bar, circular sofa and two circular tables. The large lunch or worktable has a beautiful wooden carved lamp. The chairs feature fine French touches.

Ritz Suite

Located in one of the hotel's legendary turrets, this large one-bedroom suite enjoys prime views of the Prado Museum from a private balcony. A modern-day homage to César Ritz, the suite has been designed as a tranquil escape from urban life with three distinct areas. The master bedroom offers a decorative lesson in serenity with pale wood floors and a Spanish leather headboard. Under a round natural mica ceiling, the living room is a light-filled space furnished with a circular sofa and tables. The luxurious marble bathrooms feature a freestanding bath and twin vanity unit.

Mandarin Suite

This new suite enjoys a wonderful position in the top floor turrets of the hotel. With private balconies, the suites overlook the hotel's quiet private garden. Designed by Parisian studio Gilles & Boissier, suites feature large master bedrooms complete with pale wooden floors, delicate design details and a striking Spanish leather headboard. Living rooms are equally enticing with a circular sofa set underneath a round natural mica ceiling, which reflects the light. The sumptuous marble bathroom features a freestanding bath and twin basins. Accommodation also includes a guest powder room.

Presidential Suite

One of the largest suites, the sumptuous Presidential Suite lies in a private setting on the third floor. Spread over 115sqm, the suite is entered via an elegant reception hall and is comprised of a stunning circular bedroom, a spacious living room, dining room and large bathroom. Enjoying an enviable location in one of the hotel's turrets, the suite enjoys a unique corner-style layout. Decorated in a signature classic contemporary style, accommodation also includes walk-in wardrobes and a guest powder room.

Royal Suite

The opulent Royal Suite is the largest in the hotel and occupies almost 190sqm of the First Floor. In the original location, as planned by César Ritz, the suite is home to several original masterpieces. With two private entrances, the sumptuous suite enjoys garden and Prado Museum views with a huge dining and living room, and kitchen. Located in a turret, the master bedroom offers an oasis of calm with an adjoining walk-in wardrobe/dressing area and a bathroom complete with a steam room and shower. Accommodation also includes a private study and guest powder room.

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
