Located a short walk from the hotel in the artistic quarter of Brera, home to quirky boutiques, bars and restaurants, the gallery houses works from Piero della Francesca to Caravaggio.

• Tours with Conservators

Guests can join a private tour of the gallery led by conservators. Visitors will learn about the aesthetic aspects of restoring masterpieces, including Raphael's *The Marriage of the Virgin (Lo Sposalizio della Vergine)* and Titian's *Portrait of Count Antonio Porcia (Ritratto del Conte Porcia)*, and discover which works are currently under restoration. EUR 600/person; minimum four participants.

• Private Evening Tours & Events

The museum is available for evening venue hire and private group tours. The elegant interiors make an exceptional setting for hosting events. Rates start from EUR 3000.

About the Pinacoteca di Brera

Opened in 1809, Milan's prestigious Pinacoteca di Brera houses some of the world's most famous Italian paintings. The collection was originally created for students at the Accademia di Belle Arti di Brera, which is located within the same building.

Today much of the collection is formed of works looted from churches and monasteries during the French occupation of Italy, and includes many paintings by Venetian masters, such as Titian, Tintoretto, the Bellini Brothers and Veronese. The gallery's masterpieces include Giovanni Bellini's *Pietà* and Andrea Mantegna's *Cristo Morto*.
