Asiate’s Spring Wine Dinner Series will take place from March through June 2015. Wine events will begin at 6:30 p.m. with a cocktail reception, followed by dinner at 7 p.m. Following the kick-off dinner on March 23, 2015, the Spring Wine Dinner Series will be featured as follows:

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- **April 22, 2015** – Winemaker, General Manager and Vineyard Manager of **Bergström Wines** Josh Bergström will lead diners on a journey of the winery’s hand-crafted sustainable wines, such as its Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, that have been cultivated from five estate vineyards in Oregon
- **May 21, 2015** – **Ruinart Champagne**’s Brand Ambassador Lacey Burke shares a selection of pure, delicate and timeless bottles that have been skillfully blended and then aged in 2,000 year-old cellars from France’s oldest Champagne house which was established in 1729
- **June 15, 2015** – Celebrated Winemaker Chris Upchurch of boutique artisan winery **Delille Cellars** in Washington will showcase Bordeaux-style wine blends as well as first growth red varietals, including Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot blends, from the Washington State terrior that use some of the oldest vines in the state
