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ROOMS AND SUITES AT MANDARIN ORIENTAL, SHENZHEN, OFFER SPECTACULAR HIGH-RISE VIEWS AND CONTEMPORARY LUXURY

The 178 luxury guest rooms and suites of Mandarin Oriental, Shenzhen, are among the largest in the city, all with panoramic, upper-floor views that include the dynamic cityscape, lush green parks, bustling Shenzhen Bay and the distant mountains of Hong Kong.

The hotel is located on the higher levels of the stunning, 79-storey building in the Futian business district of the booming city. All rooms and suites have floor-to-ceiling windows, luxury furnishings, spa-style bathrooms and hi-tec devices by renowned names such as Dyson, Samsung and Bose.

The 162 elegantly-designed guest rooms range from 56sqm to 76sqm, making them among the most spacious in Shenzhen. The 16 exquisitely-appointed suites range from the 114sqm Deluxe View Suite up to the 400 sqm Presidential Suite. Guests staying in club rooms and suites have access to The Mandarin Club on the 78th floor, an exclusive retreat that offers a comfortably relaxing environment, a private area for business discussions, drinks and snacks and awesome views.

The guest rooms have a light and airy contemporary vibe and an ergonomically-friendly desk and chair, making them ideal for business, or leisure, travellers. The sumptuous bathrooms feature grey marble throughout, double basins, walk-in rain showers and toiletries by diptique. The room choices are Deluxe View Room, Skyline View Room, Premier View Room and Club Skyline View Room.

Designers sought to create a tranquil and homely feel, using elements from East and West, in keeping with the broader Mandarin Oriental ethos. A muted colour scheme of beige and grey earth tones, and soft lighting, creates a relaxed mood, with a splash of colour provided by the carpets, designed in the style of an abstract painting.

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All fittings and fixtures are state of the art and include a 55" Samsung TV, Nespresso machine and Bose speaker. Numerous thoughtful touches ensure that guests are comfortable, including a valet closet to minimise disturbance and an elegant, full-length mirror. The beds come with Quivera linen and a pillow menu, so guests can select the filling that suits them best to ensure a good night's sleep.

Every room comes with breath-taking views of the economic marvel that is Shenzhen, with a cityscape that includes soaring skyscrapers, the green sub-tropical lushness of Lotus Hill Park and Bijia Hill Park, Shenzhen Bay and the far mountains of Hong Kong.

The suites have similarly splendid vistas. The 114sqm Deluxe View Suite faces east, allowing guests to see the sun rising, with the west-facing Skyline View Suite well placed for capturing the sun set over the city and the nightly light show. The 190sqm Oriental Suite looks out over historic Bijia Hill Park, while the 190sqm Mandarin Suite offers a bird's eye view of the iconic Ping An Financial Centre, the highest building in the city. All suites have large screen TVs. In some suites, the deep bathtubs also offer spectacular views to enjoy while having a long soak.

The absolute pinnacle of luxury, style and space is the Presidential Suite with its lofty views and palatial splendour. The 400sqm suite is divided into separate areas, including a zone for dining, with its own kitchen, that allows guests to host elaborate dinner gatherings for friends and associates. The hotel's gourmet chefs can suggest enticing menus served by discreetly attentive staff.

The high-ceilinged suite includes a plushly-decorated bedroom, an ensuite marble bathroom with a spa-like atmosphere and a total of five strategically placed television sets.



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Presidential Suite guests – and others – have the option of arriving in spectacular style at Mandarin Oriental, Shenzhen. A helipad allows guests to touch down and make their way to rooms and suites in a matter of mere minutes. All rooms and suites are a short elevator ride from the hotel's eight restaurants and bars.

The final piece in the hotel's luxury-accommodation jigsaw is The Mandarin Club, a refined oasis of serene calm and sublime service, where drinks, including specially designed cocktails, and snacks, are served.

Club members enjoy a host of other benefits including private check in, three pieces of complimentary clothes pressing per day, and two-hour usage of a discreetly located meeting room.

Another novel service is a choice of different aromatic oils that are then installed in the guest's in-room aromatic machine. The Mandarin Club guests also have the option of having a splash of perfume, or cologne, from the vials specially selected for storage in the lounge.

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
