Located on the third floor of the Nihonbashi Mitsui Tower and within the third floor of the adjacent Mitsui Main Building (important cultural property), the elegant facilities include a pillarless divisible grand ballroom, four banquet rooms, and six meeting rooms.

Mandarin Oriental, Tokyo has set a new benchmark in conference technology in Japan. The ballroom is fitted with 36 projectors enabling 360-degree projection of photo images and CG - the first installation of its kind in Japan. In addition, all our rooms are fitted with high speed internet connection, both wired and wireless. We also offer screens in all conference and meeting rooms, a cutting-edge lighting system, TV conferencing facilities and LAN cabling on request.

WEDDINGS: Begin your journey in the "Birthplace of Tokyo - Nihonbashi" Weddings at Mandarin Oriental, Tokyo offer legendary service and a supreme cuisine that deserve the name of the art of dining. CHAPEL:

The tranquil and spacious Sanctuary Chapel is one of the largest chapels in Tokyo. The lofty ceilings, reaching up to seven metres at their highest point, rise up over an altar surrounded by a serene pool of water, and an impressive aisle measuring 18 metres in length. The chapel's appointments are ceremoniously and spectacularly illuminated by a state-of-the-art lighting system. A priest will direct wedding ceremonies for couples-to-be, who will proceed down the aisle accompanied by a chorus of male and female voices backed by an organ and a string quartet.
