Next, rice hulls are applied to warm the body during a full body shiatsu-style massage that releases muscle tension and aids relaxation. A fresh plum juice drink completes the experience.

The 90 minute *Totally Tokyo "Five" Journeys from Nihonbashi* treatment is priced at 41,000 yen (exclusive of tax and service charge).
