# **DESTINATION**

#### **Doha Overview**

Doha, the capital of Qatar, is one of the Middle East's key business and flight hubs. A derivative of the Arabic word for bay or gulf, 'dohat', Doha is named after the bay area surrounding the city's Al Corniche.

In the early 20th century, Doha became known for the pearl trade, which played a pivotal commercial role in the city. However, it was the discovery of oil in 1940 that heralded Doha's economic and social rise, transforming the city into a global player.

On the world sporting scene, Doha hosted its first major sports event, the Qatar Open in 1993 followed by the Asian Games in 2006, which led to the development of Aspire Zone, a 250-hectare sporting complex. Football is the most popular sport in Qatar, the city is set to host football's most prestigious event in 2022, FIFA World Cup. In addition, Qatar will host for the second time the prestigious Asian Games in 2030.


Today, Doha is one of the Middle East's most dynamic metropolises and is a phenomenal destination for architecture lovers with impressive modern buildings juxtaposed along traditional structures. The Museum of Islamic Art, National Museum of Qatar, Qatar National Library, Qatar National Convention Centre and Imam Abdul Wahhab Mosque are great representations of architectural masterpieces.

# **Hotel & Location**

With its central location, the hotel is within walking distance to Souq Waqif and a short distance to the business area of West Bay and other leading attractions.

The Msheireb Downtown Doha project is the vision of Her Highness Sheikha Moza bint Nasser to preserve and reconnect the city and its residents with its traditions and heritage and to re-create a sense of community and togetherness. Spread over 31-hectares and compromising over 100 buildings, Msheireb Downtown Doha is a huge engineering feat which aims to revive the old commercial heart of Doha to become the world's first sustainable downtown regeneration project.

#### Climate & Weather

The weather in Qatar is generally warm throughout the year, with the hottest months usually between May and September. The average temperatures during the summer months can reach over 40 degrees Celsius. During the cooler months, it may come as a surprise that temperature drops between 15 to 25 degrees Celsius in December, January and February.

The official language of Qatar is Arabic. English is widely used for business and communication.

## Currency

The Qatari Riyal (QAR) is the country's official currency. The exchange rate is pegged to the US Dollar at USD 1 to QAR 3.64.

# **Respecting the Local Culture**

Qatar is a conservative country, with a pre-dominant Muslim community. It is important for visitors to be sensitive and respect the local culture.

#### **Dress Code**

The general rule is to dress conservatively and avoid revealing attire.

#### For Ladies

- Please ensure the entire torso is covered, without exposing shoulders, upper parts of the chest or arms
- Trousers, shorts or dresses should not be shorter than knee length
- Avoid overly tight or transparent/sheer clothing
- Abaya (the traditional Qatari dress) or Hijab (headscarf) is not mandatory
- Dress code in hotels or private clubs may be more relaxed

#### For Men

- The general rule is to wear long trousers or long shorts and shirts which cover shoulders and torso
- Do not wear baseball caps in bars/clubs
- Qataris don't take offence when a non-Qatari wears the national dress; a long, flowing white garment called the Thobe and the headdress called the Ghutra

#### **Alcohol Consumption**

Guests will be asked to present official identification, such as a passport or Qatari ID card, for registering prior to entering a bar. Please refrain from public drunkenness and display's of intoxication as this may lead to prosecution by local authorities.

# **Public Displays of Affection**

We advise our guests to avoid any public displays of affection or intimate behaviour which can be offensive to local residents and may be punishable by law.

# **Top Attractions**

Qatar offers a range of attractions to suit all visitors. Whether travelling for business or leisure, our Concierge can provide recommendations.

#### National Museum of Qatar (10-minute drive from the hotel)

Designed by French architect, Jean Nouvel, the National Museum of Qatar is inspired by a natural desert rock formation known as the "desert rose." This unique building embraces the newly restored Palace of Sheikh Abdullah bin Jassim Al-Thani, which itself represents the heart of Qatari identity. Visitors are immersed in a journey through Qatar's history with three "chapters" - Beginnings, Life in Qatar, and The Modern History of Qatar presented across eleven galleries.

#### Museum of Islamic Art (5-minute drive from the hotel)

Located on Al Corniche promenade, the iconic Museum of Islamic Art houses a fascinating collection of exhibits from three continents spanning over 1,400 years. Designed by the late master architect I. M. Pei, the landmark building is an architectural masterpiece. From the intricate treasures, to the uninterrupted view of the city's magnificent skyline from outside, this is a must for anyone visiting Doha.



#### Msheireb Museums (5-minute walk from the hotel)

The Msheireb Museums span four historic heritage houses celebrating Qatar's national history and a living showcase of traditional Qatari architecture. The houses reveal unique aspects of Qatar's cultural and social development to help preserve the country's historical treasures. The museums offer a great insight into the history of Qatar and Msheireb Downtown Doha.

# **Qatar National Library (20-minute drive or by Metro from the hotel)**

Qatar National Library acts as a steward of Qatar's national heritage and preserves the Heritage Collection, which consists of valuable texts and manuscripts related to the Arab-Islamic civilization. The nation's public library currently boasts more than one million books in its collections, along with more than 500,000 eBooks, periodicals and newspapers, and special collections. There are also relaxation areas, workstations, exhibition spaces and a children's library.

# Soug Wagif (10-minute walk from the hotel)

A labyrinth of colour and culture, Souq Waqif is a maze of restaurants, galleries and stalls lined with cobbled alleys and avenues, reminiscent of a traditional Qatari town. Traditional music, art and cultural shows – as well as an eclectic mix of shops – add to the ambience of this special place. The top two attractions to visit are the Gold Souq and Falcon Souq.

#### Al Bidda Park

Al Bidda Park is Qatar's largest park located in the heart of Doha, providing a peaceful escape from the bustling city. The park includes expansive areas with dedicated tracks for biking as well open-air playgrounds, outdoor exercise equipment and other recreational and service facilities. Guests can conveniently visit Al Bidda Park from Msheireb Metro Station to the Al Bidda Metro Station.

The dhow is a traditional Qatari fishing boat, the primary means of transportation and for fishing and pearling in the past. Most of these traditional dhows are restored and now offer visitors a mesmerizing experience cruising along the coast and Al Corniche.

#### **Dune Bashing**

Dune bashing is an exhilarating experience which visitors can enjoy in the comfort of a luxury sport utility vehicle handled by professional drivers. Upon leaving from the city centre, visitors can expect to traverse sand dunes of the Qatari desert to the amazing inland sea. 




Bathroom control unit (lighting)





# SAFETY, SECURITY & EMERGENCY

Mandarin Oriental, Doha takes the safety and security of guests and colleagues with the utmost regard. The hotel complies with stringent fire and safety standards. All guestrooms, floors and public areas are fitted with smoke detectors and a sprinkler system, as well as a CCTV system for security surveillance in public areas.

Please take the time to familiarise yourself with the following information and contact Reception for more details or queries relating to safety, security and emergency procedures.

In emergencies, please press the "Emergency" button on the telephone or dial "0" for the Operator.

# **Upon Check-in**

Please familiarise yourself with the security and safety information and features at the hotel:

- The nearest Emergency Exits and Exit Paths from your guestroom are marked on the Emergency Evacuation Plan displayed on the back of your guestroom door
- Take note of the nearest fire alarm switch and fire extinguisher
- A torch is placed in the drawer of the bedside table
- An Emergency button is located on telephones in the guestroom

For guests with accessibility needs, please inform Reception at check-in and/or contact them for details.

#### **During Your Stay**

For the comfort and safety of guests and colleagues, please note the following:

- The use of bokhour, shisha, charcoal, flame torch devices, candles and joss sticks are prohibited in guestrooms unless approved by senior management.
- For guests in smoking designated guestrooms, please avoid smoking in bed and ensure cigarettes and matches are disposed only in ashtrays and extinguished properly after use.
- Please ensure battery chargers, electrical or electronic devices are turned off and unplugged after use, particularly when away from the guestroom.
- Any type of cooking is prohibited in guestrooms, except for those equipped with kitchen.
- Please advise Concierge or Reception if you are attending activities such as desert safaris, dune bashing, diving, motor

racing ...etc.

 Please avoid leaving children, under 12 years old, unattended in guestrooms, particularly those with a balcony or terrace.

# **Detecting Fire or Smoke**

#### **Hotel Public Area**

When you detect fire or smoke in a public area of the hotel, please remain calm and follow the below guidelines:

- Activate the nearest fire alarm switch or immediately notify any nearby colleagues
- Identify and proceed to the nearest Emergency Exit

#### Guestroom

When you detect fire or smoke in your guestroom, please remain calm and follow the below quidelines:

- Activate the nearest fire alarm switch located in the guest floor corridor or use the "Emergency" button on the telephone or dial "0" for the Operator
- Identify and proceed to the nearest and safest Emergency Exit

For guests with accessibility needs, please use the "Emergency" button on the telephone or dial "0" for the Operator or seek assistance directly from hotel colleagues.

#### Fire Alarm Sounds

If fire alarm sounds, please remain calm, listen and follow the instructions broadcasted on the public-address system.

#### **Evacuation**

If an evacuation is necessary, this will be broadcasted on the public-address system. In case of an evacuation due to fire, before opening your questroom door to leave, touch and feel if it is hot:

#### If the door is NOT hot:

- Identify the nearest Emergency Exits and Exit Paths shown on the back of your guestroom door
- Open the door slightly and identify the nearest and safest Emergency Exit and Path
- Prepare to leave guestroom
  - Bring your room keycard, if possible
  - Do not bring any luggage
  - Take note of everyone in guestroom and leave together
  - Close guestroom door upon exiting
- Do not use elevators under any circumstances
- Proceed to the nearest Emergency Exit staircase and if there is smoke in the corridor, stay low as you proceed to the Emergency Exit staircase
- Proceed down the staircase until you exit from the building to the designated assembly point
- If you cannot use the Emergency Exit staircase or if it becomes unsafe, please return to your room or exit to a guest floor corridor and knock on guestroom doors to seek shelter, if other guests are within, or continue to find a safe place to shelter

#### If the door is hot:

- Do not open and remain in guestroom
- Seek assistance by using the Emergency button or dial "0" on the telephone
- Turn-off air conditioning system and close windows or any exterior facing doors to prevent air flow which will draw in smoke or fire
- Place wet towels under the door or in air vents to prevent smoke from entering and to keep your body cool, if necessary
