Travelers came to Italy for its fantastic glassware, mainly being produced in Venice. While stopping over, travelers would bring tropical fruits and herbs while indulging in the local alcohol being produced, Amaro.

The early parts of the Silk Route, travelling through Persia, was known as the Royal Road. The name came from the rich and famous who were the only ones who could afford to use the route for trading. e route had stops which included stables with horses so travelling would take less time as they were able to have a rested horse to take the goods.

### TALAD NAAM

Dragon Fruit | Papaya | Thai Basil | Passionfruit

Southeast Asia started becoming a part of the Silk Route when there was a demand for its tropical fruits and jasmine rice. At risk of the fruit's quality dropping with each passing day, Thailand would use the Mekong river to transport them quicker. Locals quickly started trading along this river and creating what is known locally as Talad Naam, floating market, which are still around today.
