# OUR DESIGN

Designed by internationally renowned RHSP (Rogers Stirk Harbour & Partners), the talent behind the Lloyd's building and the 'Cheesegrater' in London, as well as the Pompidou Centre in Paris, the building's design has a rich historic context, given its location on the corner of Mayfair's oldest square.

Inspired by the Georgian terraces of Hanover Square, RSHP crafted a distinctive Vierendeel structured building – a pioneering design in the UK and a rarity in modern engineering. The exterior exudes grandeur, seamlessly blending with the Square's historic ambiance. Notably, the burnt red brick 'baquettes' utilised are the longest bricks in the UK, adding to the building's unique character. A strong sense of place has inspired the interior design of the hotel's public spaces, created by Tokyo based studio, Curiosity, who have based their concept on 'a hub of nature and art'. As a homage to the hotel's cultural and creative neighbours, artworks by local British artists feature throughout the hotel with one-off furniture pieces curated by Curiosity's founder, Gwenael Nicolas.

The guest rooms, suites and apartments have been designed by UK based Studio Indigo, embracing a British style influenced by the hotel's iconic location in the heart of London, while encompassing touches reflective of the Group's oriental heritage.

# MANDARIN ORIENTAL MAYFAIR, London's fan

Nestled in the heart of Mayfair's Hanover Square, the new Mandarin Oriental sits just across from 44 Conduit Street, the Mayfair home of the Vivienne Westwood boutique. Through a shared love of the historic area, one of London's finest and oldest squares, Mandarin Oriental worked with Vivienne Westwood to design a handcrafted fan to illustrate this elegant square – a signature emblem to inform the individuality of the new Mandarin Oriental.

The inspiration for the fan started with the historic Square, named in honour of George I, the Elector of Hanover. The square was laid out in the late 1710s and was originally lined with fine terraced houses, occupied by some of London's most celebrated society figures. 'The design of the fan sees two figures meeting, dancing – theatrically. They are alive – well dressed- mysterious, perhaps friends meeting in the afternoon, perhaps glamorous lovers - inspired by traditional paper cut-outs and the models from our campaigns. We framed the silhouettes on a hand drawing of the square. To respect the space of the fan – we turned it upside down – it fits! Vivienne did this in the early years in her Worlds End shop with an image of Piccadilly Circus upside down. Turning it on its head.'

The fan is a testament to British craftsmanship, meticulously handcrafted in the UK. Ian Block, from the esteemed Worshipful Company of Fan Makers, established in 1709, spearheaded the assembly, uniting time-honoured artisanal techniques and expertise.





### ASSEMBLY POINT

# SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

We have taken every responsible precaution to ensure your comfort and safety, however in the unlikely event of an emergency, we recommend you familiarise yourself with our basic safety instructions.

# **EMERGENCY NUMBER**

In case of an emergency, dial "3333" from any house phone. This number should be used only for an emergency and not for connecting with different services within the hotel. Should the hotel telephone system be down, please use your mobile device to dial "999". We recommend you familiarise yourself with your surroundings on reaching your bedroom.

- Take note of the location of the two nearest fire exits.
- Count the number of doorways between your room and at least two emergency exits.
- Check the location of the nearest fire alarm call point (red break glass box).
- Check the control of your room's air conditioning unit and how to switch it off.
- Leave your room key in an accessible place.
- Always take your room key with you when leaving.
- Carefully check the evacuation plan located on your room door.

# **EVACUATION**

In case the sirens sound please follow the evacuation plan affixed to your room door and always follow the fire exit signs. In the unlikely event of an evacuation, the following is recommended:

- Stay calm and do not panic.
- Leave your belongings in the room.
- If you must open a door always touch the door with your hand and only proceed if it is cool and safe to do so.
- After passing through a door always close it behind you so a fire cannot spread.
- You must evacuate the building by the safest and nearest fire exit.
- If there is smoke in the corridor, stay low and count the doors to the nearest fire exit.
- Do not try and use a lift to exit during a fire alarm activation. The lifts will not respond to your call.
- Once outside the building go to the assembly point in Hanover Square.
- Once outside, never re-enter the building until the 'all clear' is given by the chief fire officer. If it is unsafe to leave your room, or your escape routes are obstructed:
- Return to your bedroom.
- Turn off your air conditioning.
- Contact reception or dial "999" and state your location.
